Decorated eggs symbolizing Christ's Resurrection

Bread, usually with a cross formed in the crust symbolizing Jesus' Death

A Lamb carved from sugar or butter representing Christ, the Paschal Lamb

Salt to represent purification

Horseradish or pepper to remind us of the bitter Sacrifice of Christ

Ham or Kielbasa to symbolize great joy and abundance
