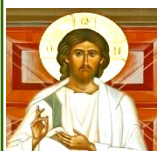

Operating income/expenses do not include any income or losses from investments. Our financial statements are subject to an independent review by the Archdiocese. Our last review was performed by BakerTilly, LLP, in January 2023 for the fiscal year ended June 30, 2022. This report is available to review in the rectory on request.

NOTES TO STATEMENTS OF INCOME AND EXPENSES

1. Additions to Church/Convent - this amount reflects the labor and materials costs expended before June 30, 2023 for the addition of a pitched rooftop on the convent. The roof was completed later in the summer of 2023 at an additional expense of \$76,496.
2. Tuition Income - This amount represents the net amount of tuition we received from school families and from outside tuition assistance sources (BLOCS, private scholarships, etc.). It should be noted that unfunded discounts are offered directly by St. Helena. For the 2022 - 2023 school year, St. Helena offered the following amounts in unfunded discounts: \$544,699 for qualified parishioners, \$220,700 in multi-child discounts for parishioners, and \$25,117 in various other unfunded discounts or financial aid paid by the parish.
3. Other Income - This amount includes a \$76,020 reimbursement from the Montgomery County Intermediate Unit for educational expenses incurred by St. Helena School (in previous fiscal years) and reimbursable under the Emergency Assistance to Non-Public Schools (EANS) program which provided emergency services or assistance to non-public schools in the wake of COVID-19. Also included in "Other Income" is \$10,052 in rebates to the school from Tipping School Pictures and from Flynn & O'Hara School Uniforms.
4. Additions to School - This amount represents costs associated with installing a new roof on the school which was installed in the summer of 2022. Nearly 100% of this expense was subsidized by the Parish.

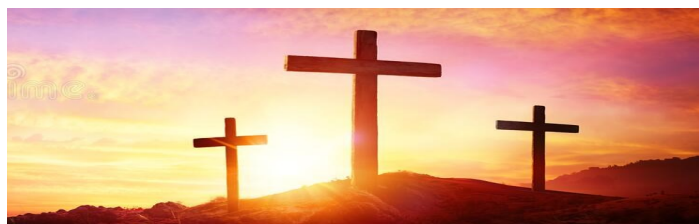

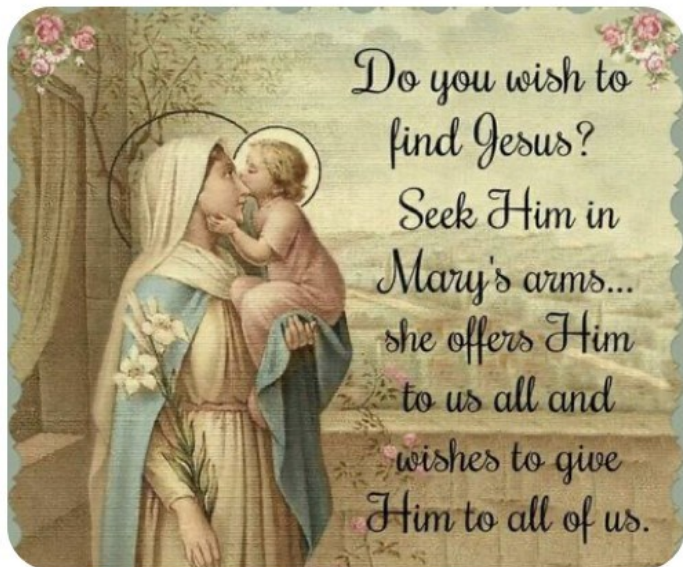
