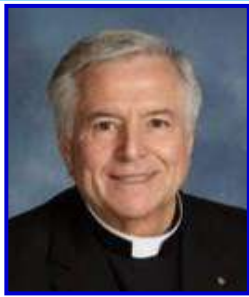

NIC NOTES

DEAR PARISHIONERS,

I would like to continue with the next five good reasons to go to Mass. They are:

6) People need our prayers. We can pray for people at any time, however when we pray for them during the Mass, we are doing this in a most special way. The Mass brings us together in the Body of Christ and we become one in the Communion of Saints. It is part of the cosmic dimension of the Mass where heaven and earth are united by reaching across time and space.

7) We need to stand up for what we believe. Being a follower of Jesus is counter cultural. At every Mass, we have the opportunity to stand up and proclaim what we believe publicly. We admit that we believe in God, in Jesus, in the Holy Spirit, in the Catholic Church, and the Communion of Saints, in the forgiveness of sins, and in life everlasting. It is a powerful statement and an opportunity to recommit ourselves.

8) We need to acknowledge that we make mistakes. At every Mass, we have the opportunity to review the past week. We admit that we have sinned in thought, in word, in deed, and what we have done and what we have failed to do. We see God's forgiveness and we are sure that God still loves us.

9) We need ritual in our lives. The Mass is a ritual. That is through the repetition of prayers, movements, and the changing of bread and wine into the Body and Blood of Christ, we are formed, disciplined, and consoled. The "sameness" of the Mass carries us along the spiritual journey. The "sameness" of the ritual allows us to be transformed on a soul level, even if we are unaware of what is happening.

10) We need to experience something bigger than ourselves. When we go to Mass, we share in the Death and Resurrection of Jesus. When we offer our ordinary lives to God through Jesus, we enter into God's great plan for the world. We are strengthened by the Eucharist and are sent out into the world to bring the good news. The Mass gives meaning and purpose to our lives; it helps us to develop a sense of wonder and awe. It allows us to see that there is something bigger than ourselves.

Having these positive attitudes about going to Mass can surprise us. Research studies have shown that people who go to church every week are: less likely to suffer from depression; less likely to abuse drugs or alcohol; more likely to have a solid sense of right and wrong; and

more likely to live a longer and happier life. So why not spread the Good News!

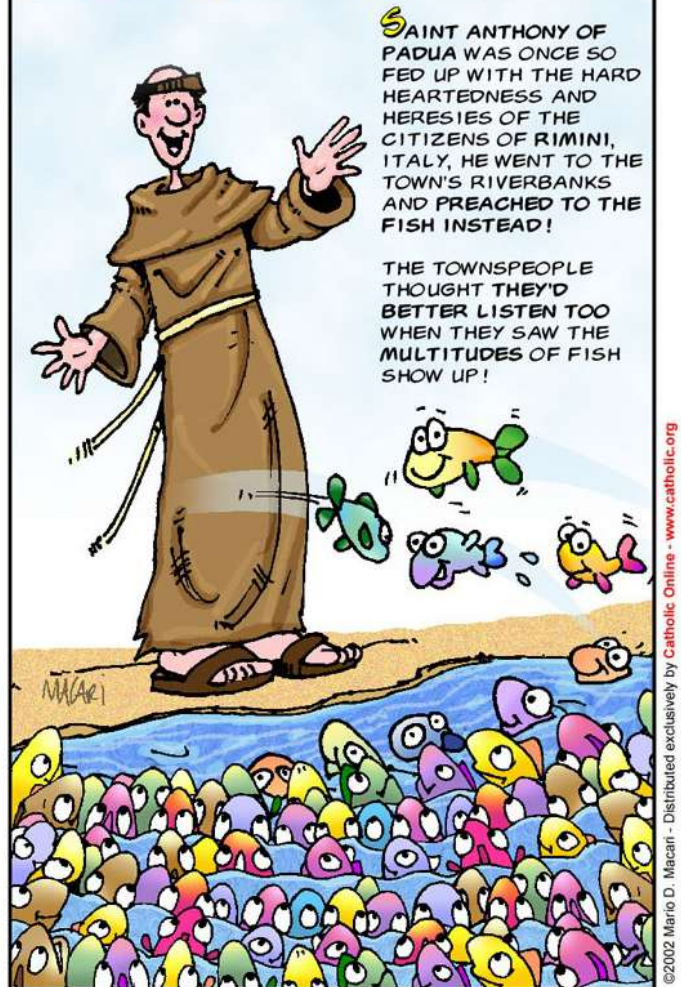

CareNotes - A Catholic Perspective

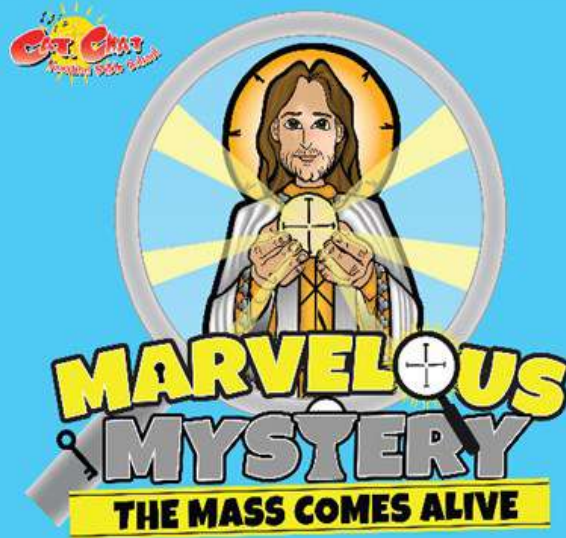
CareNotes, a ministry of Saint Meinrad Archabbey, are booklets written to provide uplifting guidance to those who are hurting.

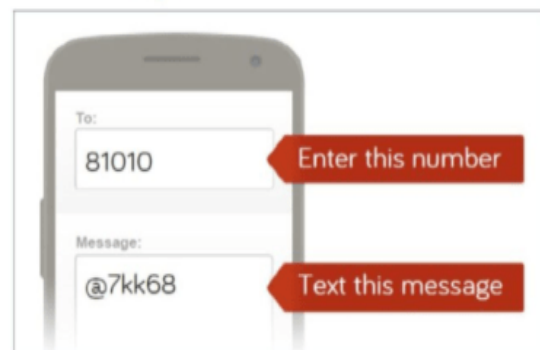
