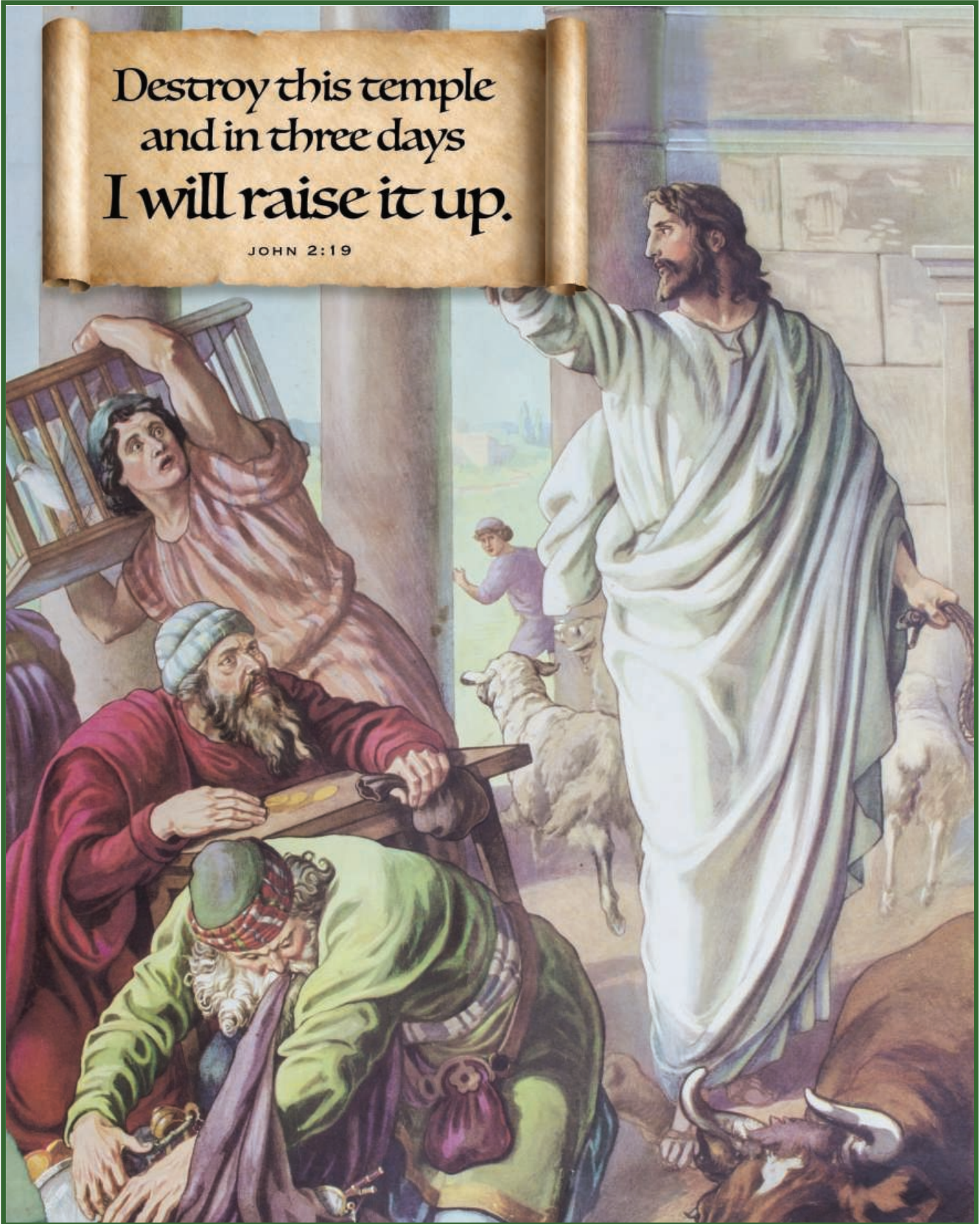

Fish Dinners Support a \$1000 Donation to Those in Great Need !

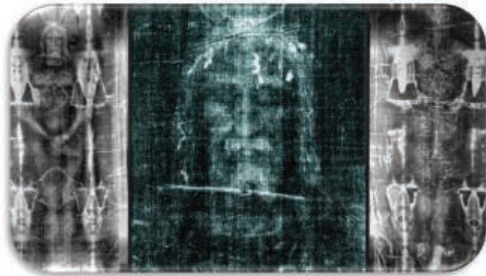
The Knights thank St. Helena parishioners who enjoyed the two Lenten Fish Dinners, ordering a record 460 plus dinners.

SUMMER FAMILY RETREAT

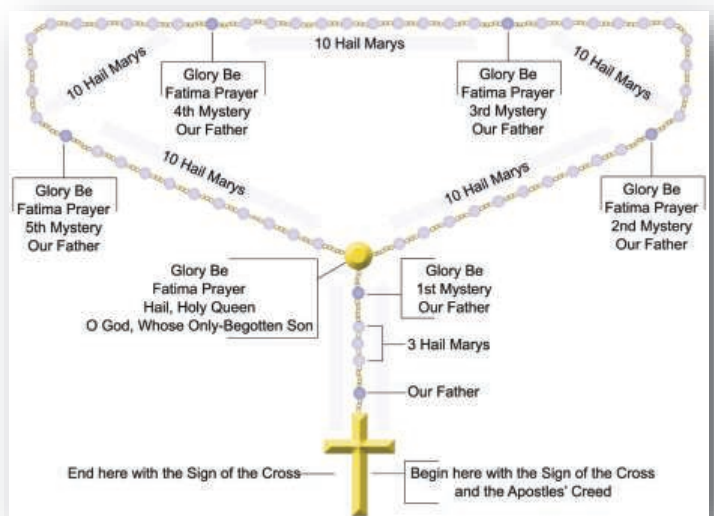
Eight to ten families (Grandparents welcome, too!) come together to form a Christ-centered community for the week or weekend.

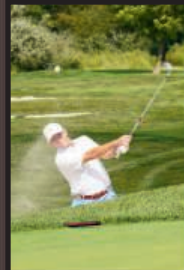
