

We have begun the holy season of Lent. As you know, the hallmarks of Lent are Prayer, Fasting, and Almsgiving. Therefore, let us focus

our attention on these. Let us make this holy season of Lent a mini retreat. Morning and Evening Prayer as well as prayers before and after meals are truly wonderful ways to start, if you are not already doing so. Scripture reading with a time of reflection and/or meditation each and every day of Lent would also be wonderful. The Rosary and the Divine Mercy Chaplet would be admirable ways to make Prayer an integral part of your Lent. Fasting not only from food or drink is another remarkable way to make your Lent fruitful. Random acts of kindness, that is, doing special things for others would also be an excellent way to "celebrate" Lent. 

MADELEINE'S MESSAGE

Saint Patrick baptized, confirmed, and ordained priests, and he erected schools and monasteries.

Thousands came into the Church under his direction. He accomplished all these activities in less than 30 years, during which time the whole island



nation of Ireland was converted. Toward the end of his life, he wrote "Confessions", in which he gives a record of his life and mission.

He died on March 17, 461 of natural causes. He is buried in Downpatrick in present-day Northern Ireland. Many stories are told in connection with St. Patrick. The three-leaf clover was said to be used by the Saintly Bishop to explain the Trinity to the pagans, which is why it is such a common Saint Patrick's Day symbol today.

Another legend has Saint Patrick driving all the snakes out of Ireland. Snakes were a popular symbol among the Irish pagans. He is certainly one of the most revered Saints of the Catholic Church.

Today, Saint Patrick is the patron saint of Ireland, many dioceses throughout the English-speaking world, and he is the Patron Saint of engineers. I hope everyone has a wonderful Saint Patrick's Day!

The Catechism of the Catholic Church on Life & Abortion (2275) states: "You shall not kill the embryo by abortion and shall not cause the newborn to perish."






