





NIC NOTES

Dear Parishioners,

So often, we hear people saying that going to Church and/or participating at Holy Mass isn't that important because

they can pray at home. Praying at home is a wonderful thing, but it does not take the place of going to Mass. Private prayer is great; when you pray at home, your prayer is personal and one dimensional. When you come to Mass, you pray with your whole being. You use all your senses. You see, hear, smell, taste and touch. You use your body by genuflecting, sitting, kneeling, standing, walking and singing.

When you go to Mass, these opportunities are given to you:

- 1. You seek forgiveness for your sins
- 2. You learn how God's Word impacts your life in the homily.
- 3. You offer yourself to the Lord.
- 4. You experience the miracle of bread and wine changing into the Body and Blood of Christ.
- 5. You reach out to others with the Peace of Christ.
- 6. You admit that you are not worthy, and then come forward to receive the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of Christ.
- 7. You receive a special blessing.
- 8. You are commissioned to go out and to make the world a better place.


The above are to assist you in realizing why the Mass is so very, very important to participate in on a regular basis. It is also very important to realize that the Mass is more than entertainment. When entertainment is the model for church worship, the leaders try to induce particular feelings in the audience.

The Mass, however, is just the opposite. It is a ritual in which people bring their own feelings and incorporate them in the Liturgy. That's why it is possible for two people to attend the same Mass, one grieving a death and the other celebrating a birth. You both feel connected. The whole point is to go beyond feelings into authentic prayer which is offering of oneself to God in Jesus Christ.

KEN'S CACHE

It's the esoteric historian who can associate this date with Catholic history, few others. But on January 22, 1899, Pope Leo XIII issued the encyclical *Testem benevolentiae*, the document condemning the alleged heresy labeled "Americanism." The heresy was a libel on American Catholics. From the beginning the "heresy" was more European than American. What's the background?

Marveling at the rapid growth of the Catholic Church in the United States, certain circles of European Catholics, in France particularly, seized upon a popularized and imprecisely translated biography of Father Isaac Hecker, who came to Catholicism partly through New England transcendentalism, to press for secular and ecumenical accommodations that theoretically would be as beneficial for the church in Europe as they had been for the church in America. Liberal European Catholics seemed especially impressed by the health and vigor a church could enjoy where it was independent from state patronage.

Isaac Hecker, to return to him, was founder of course of the Missionary Society of St. Paul the Apostle, better known as the Paulists. He acquired a wide reputation for winning converts, in part by emphasizing those things which Catholics and Protestants held in common, rather than those which separated them. That approach, highlighted in the translation, is the cornerstone of the modern ecumenical movement, but, in 1899 it smacked of compromise, of dilution of doctrine, of a waiving of prerogatives. The very idea was anathema in Rome. Problem was, in issuing his condemnations, Leo was addressing the wrong audience.

Though the "Americanism" name given the incident would stick, the reality was that the issues that troubled Leo did not exist in the American church. The church was not in radical ferment; it was loyalist. Leo XIII subsequently realized this, and three years later issued a congratulatory message to American Catholics for the loyalty and "Liberality."




Do you tithe electronically?
