

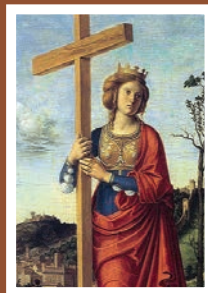

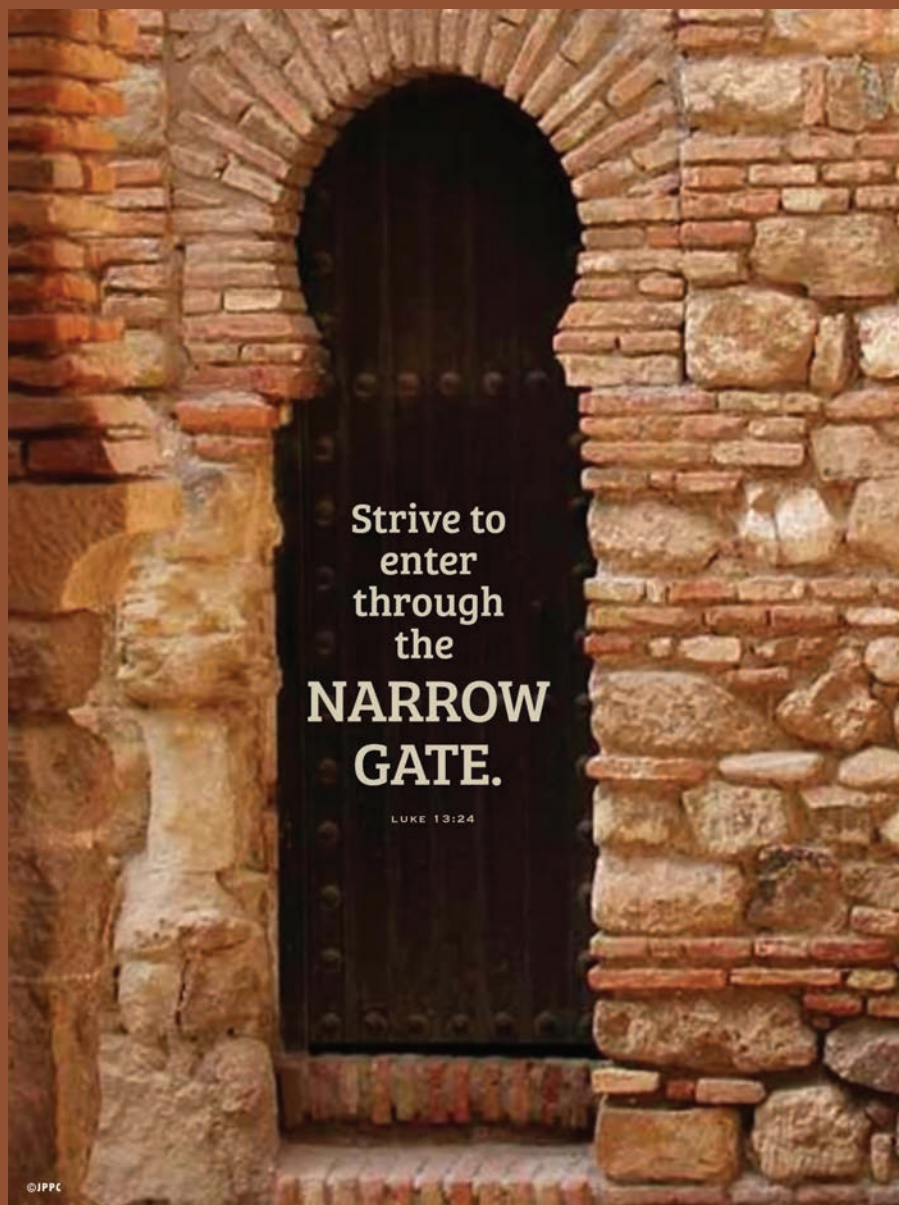

Saturdays at 2:45 PM in the Church or contact the Parish Office to make an appointment.

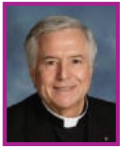

### NIC NOTES

DEAR PARISHIONERS,

Last week I wrote about what it means to take ownership in a true sense of one's parish. I'd like to share with you some thoughts, insights, and comments.

One should always think of himself or herself as part of a parish family. A family shares memories, common heritage and history. Families are grounded in the same beliefs, values and traditions. They embrace new members of the family with love and acceptance. Family members do not always agree with one another all the time, but they feel a strong commitment to one another and to the family as a whole. This is true of a parish family too.

We should be welcoming. When you come to Mass, think of it as a large family reunion. Some people we know very well, some we know slightly and some we do not know at all. Like at a family reunion, introduce yourself to people you don't know. The Parish is part of your family. Non-verbal communication is also very powerful. A nod of the head and a smile can go a long way. Mother Teresa of Calcutta once said, "Every time you smile at someone, it is an action of love, a gift to that person, a beautiful thing."

God has given us all gifts and talents that are unique. God intends them to be shared; so use them in your parish. Get involved in a ministry, a committee, or an organization. Any expertise in business, finance, computer, public relations, photography, engineering, carpentry, building maintenance, or skills like cooking, baking, cleaning, or gardening—can find a place in the parish. You might even have an idea for a new ministry, support group, organization or event. Even your energy and your enthusiasm can build up your parish family.

The Mass is the "heart" and central focus of the parish, however parish ministries, activities and even events increase spirituality and build a sense of community. Take advantage of all of the opportunities your parish family has for you to meet new people and feel more connected. Invite others—family members, friends, neighbors, co-workers—to meet your parish family at a Sunday Mass, or any parish event.

Even if someone isn't "open" or ready to come to Mass, he or she just might enjoy coming to a parish event, meeting some new people and having fun. Many a "door" has opened after such an invitation.

Everything we have and everything we are is a gift from God. We need to recognize that. When we do, we see that giving to the parish financially and generously is an essential part of our spirituality. You know how expensive it is to run your home; your parish faces much higher costs and depends on you to help meet them.

Pray for your parish. Keep your pastor, parochial vicar, parish staff and fellow parishioners in your daily prayers. Saying the Rosary, spending time in Adoration in our Chapel, fasting, offering up any suffering, annoyance or inconvenience for your parish family can help build us up. As you do this, you see yourself as a spiritual support for all the good work being done in and through your parish.

Remember, no parish is perfect. Just imagine if each one of us—the members of our parish family—would do something to make our parish better. Wow!

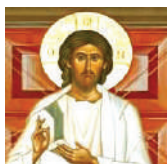

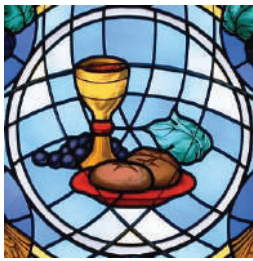

## KEN'S CACHE

One cannot ignore the issues around immigration today without wondering what the Church's stand is on this issue. What emerges is that globalization has been a decidedly mixed bag. So, for the next two weeks we will look at the immigration issue as it relates to the Church and our world.

On the plus side, it's managed to knit diverse people together economically and, to a lesser degree, culturally. But it's also further divided others along religious, political, racial and class lines.

It's introduced us to a myriad of once-exotic consumer products at relatively cheaper prices — cheaper for many Westerners, that is. Globalization has also brought us fresh ideas and life choices that — while I certainly don't agree with every new view put forth — have enormously enriched my own life experience.

On the negative side — and this is huge — it's allowed multinational corporate boards and shareholders to escape the full weight of responsibility for the enormous environmental degradation their decisions have produced in exploited regions thousands of miles from their posh corporate headquarters.

Let us not forget the foreign workers — including child laborers — exploited by unscrupulous employers trying to satisfy their Western customers' insatiable demand for rock bottom prices.

For the United States and other Western nations, globalization's complex outcomes have produced still another key Gordian knot dilemma. I'm referring to the vast numbers of desperate human refugees heading — most often without proper documentation — to the United States, Europe, Australia and even neighboring countries that may be only relatively better off.

The latter group includes situations American news media rarely cover. They include Nicaraguans fleeing to Costa Rica and South Africa's burgeoning refugee population composed of hopeful immigrants from a variety of sub-Saharan African nations.

Is it any surprise to anyone with a working knowledge of homo sapiens that we demand globalization's creature comforts without wanting to deal with those actual Homo sapiens that globalization has negatively impacted?

Religious leaders have long involved themselves in the immigration debate, taking a variety of pro and con positions. But what about rank-and-file religious believers? How do they feel about the massive movements of immigrants?

Does religiosity make people more welcoming, or more suspicious, of the stranger? More next week.



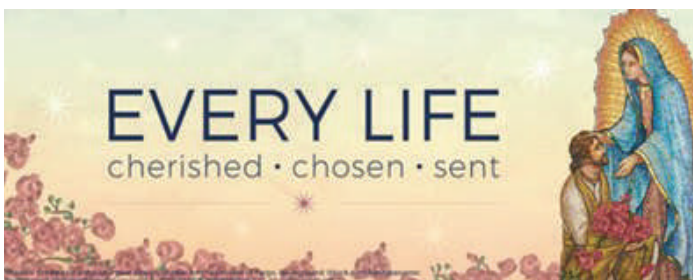
Help Those in Need with ESL Classes

St. Bartholomew (1st. Century)  
Feast Day August 24.

All that is known of him with certainty is that he is mentioned in the synoptic gospels and Acts as one of the twelve apostles. His name, a patronymic, means "son of Tolomai" and scholars believe he is the same as Nathanael mentioned in John, who says he is from Cana and that Jesus called him an "Israelite...incapable of deceit." The Roman Martyrology says he preached in India and Greater Armenia, where he was flayed and beheaded by King Astyages. Tradition has the place as Abanopolis on the west coast of the Caspian Sea and that he also preached in Mesopotamia, Persia, and Egypt. The Gospel of Bartholomew is apochryphal and was condemned in the decree of Pseudo-Gelasius.

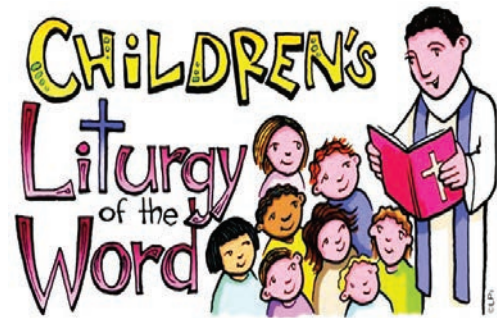

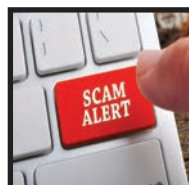
