### VOLUNTEER POSITIONS AVAILABLE!

**Do you have a love for God and your Catholic Faith? Do you have a desire to share your faith with others? Do you enjoy working with children?**

If you answered “yes” to these questions, please consider teaching or serving as an aide or office assistant in our *Religious Education Program!* Our Religious Education Program serves children in Levels 1 through 7 by forming them in their relationship with Jesus Christ, cultivating and nurturing their knowledge and practice of the Catholic faith, and preparing them for reception of the Sacraments of Reconciliation, Eucharist, and Confirmation.

**We have openings in our Tuesday evening weekly program for both elementary and middle school class levels.** Applicants must be practicing Catholics, living in accord with Catholic teachings, and have a love for God and the Catholic Faith. They should be 18 or older and be able to relate to and work with children. While prior experience teaching is always beneficial, it is not required. Responsibilities for the Catechist position include preparing and teaching lessons for a class of roughly 20 children using published and prescribed materials provided by the program, and maintaining periodic email communication with families. For our weekly program, applicants must be available Tuesday evenings from 6:00 – 7:30 PM, September through May. Full materials, training, support, and certification for the Catechist position are provided to every volunteer in order to equip them for this position. Background checks and adherence to the Archdiocesan Safe Environment Program are required.

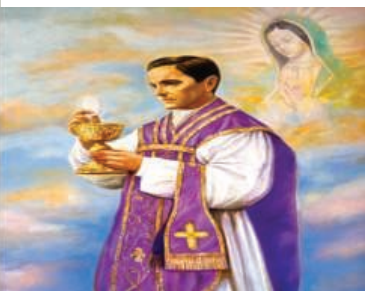

**USCCB’s Reflection on the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary**

“The Solemnity of the Assumption celebrates the Blessed Mother’s entrance into heavenly glory. The *Catechism* explains that Mary ‘was taken up body and soul into the glory of heaven, where she already shares in the glory of her Son’s Resurrection, anticipating the resurrection of all members of his Body’ (CCC, 974).

Mary’s Assumption into heaven reminds us that life on earth is a pilgrimage to our ultimate destination. We prepare in hope for our own passage into eternal life by the choices we make today. When we choose to love and follow God in our daily lives, we strengthen our relationship with Him, and this relationship is the true meaning of heaven: “To live in heaven is ‘to be with Christ’” (CCC, 1025).

We can see how, throughout her life, the Blessed Mother continually chose to go more deeply into her relationship with God. She modeled how to value and respect His precious gift of human life, from the moment of conception to its natural end. In the Annunciation, through her “yes,” Mary witnessed to the undeniable humanity of pre-born children as she conceived and carried the Christ Child in her womb. After the Annunciation, having learned that her cousin Elizabeth was with child, she went in haste to her aid.

Our Blessed Mother shows us how the way we live today can prepare us, in hope, to also enter into heavenly glory at the end of our lives. Are we open to God’s precious gift of new life? How do we support pregnant mothers and parents? Do we prioritize showing our love to those who are ill or aging? Do we care for them in a way that respects God’s gift of life?”

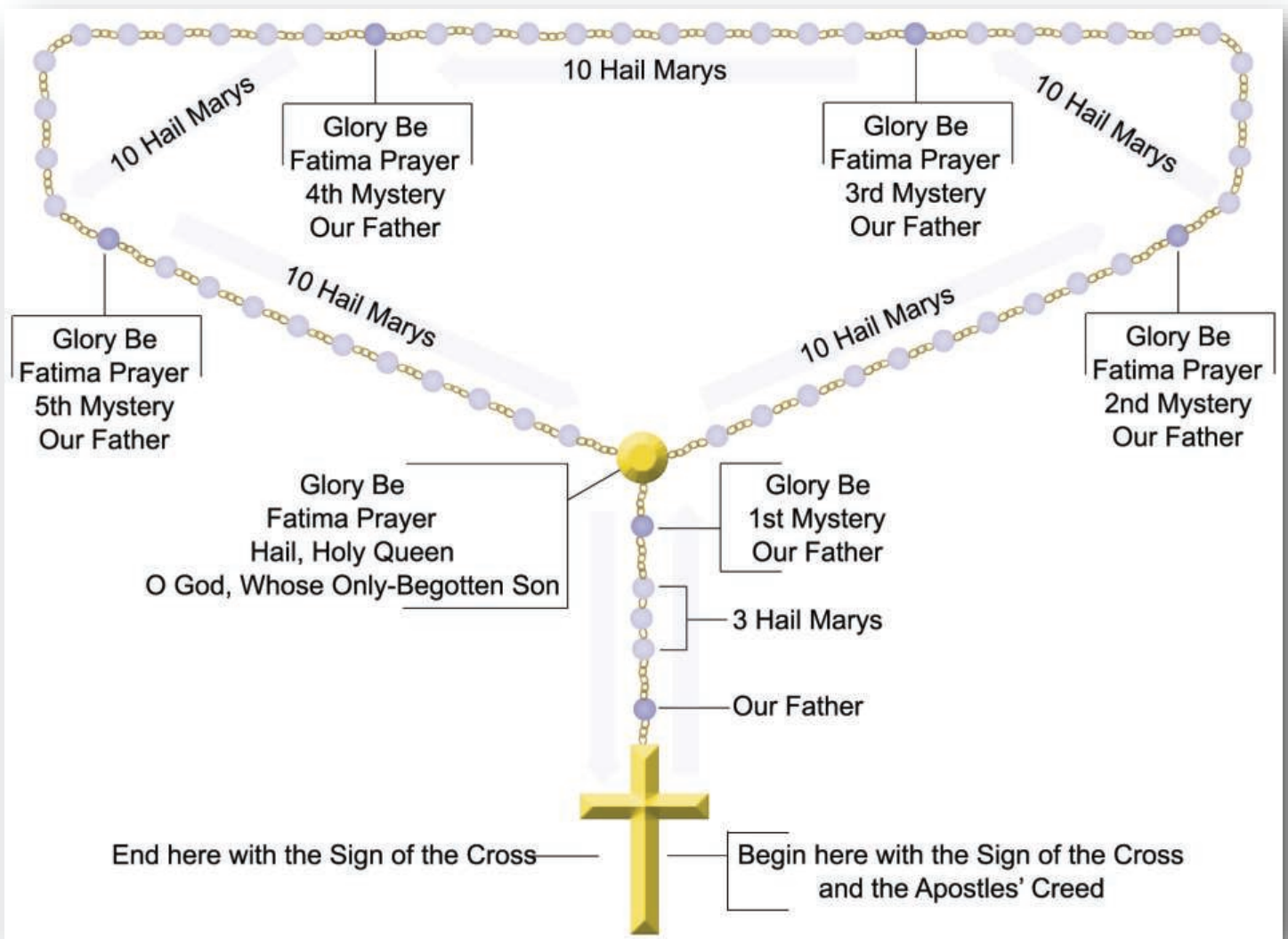
