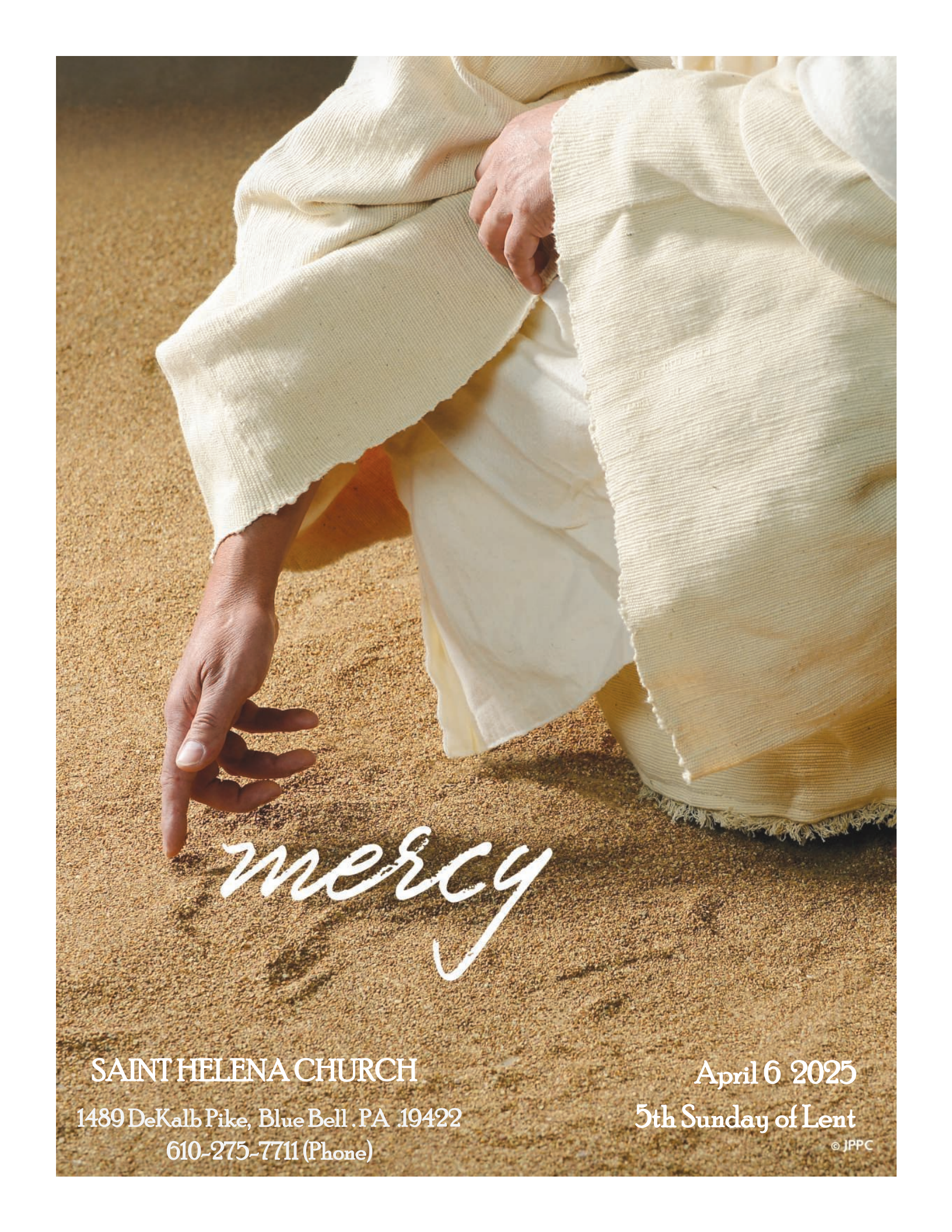

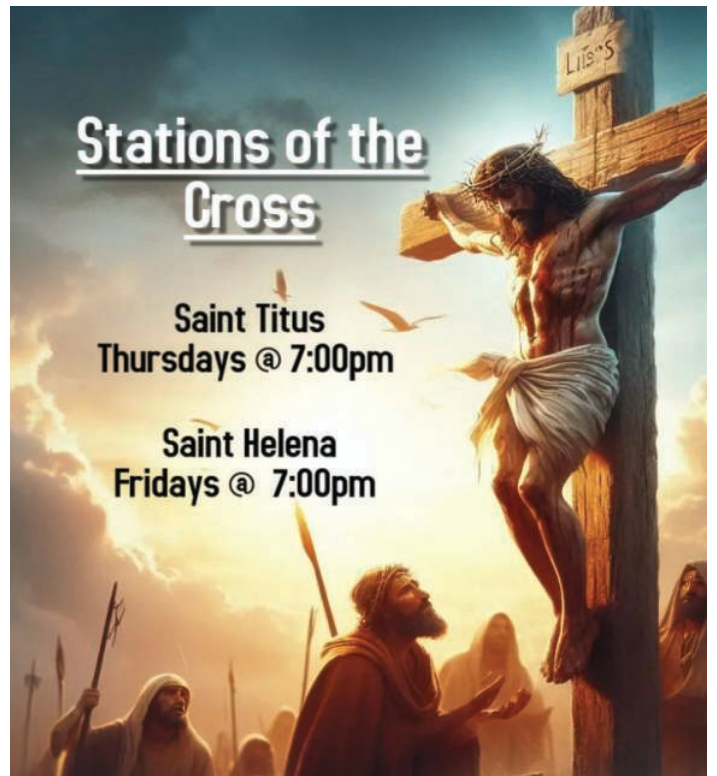
Easter Food Drive

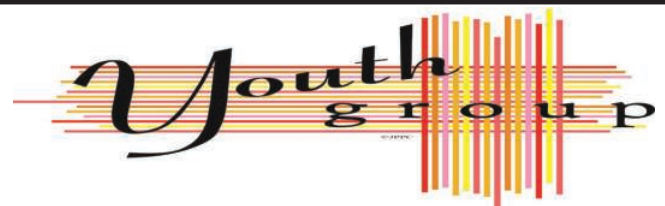

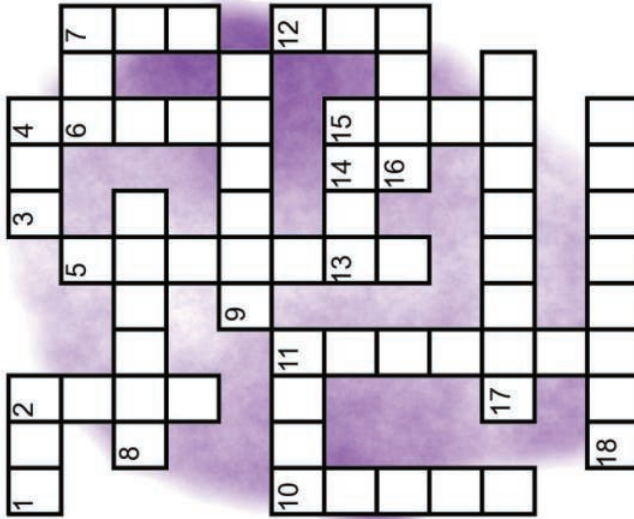

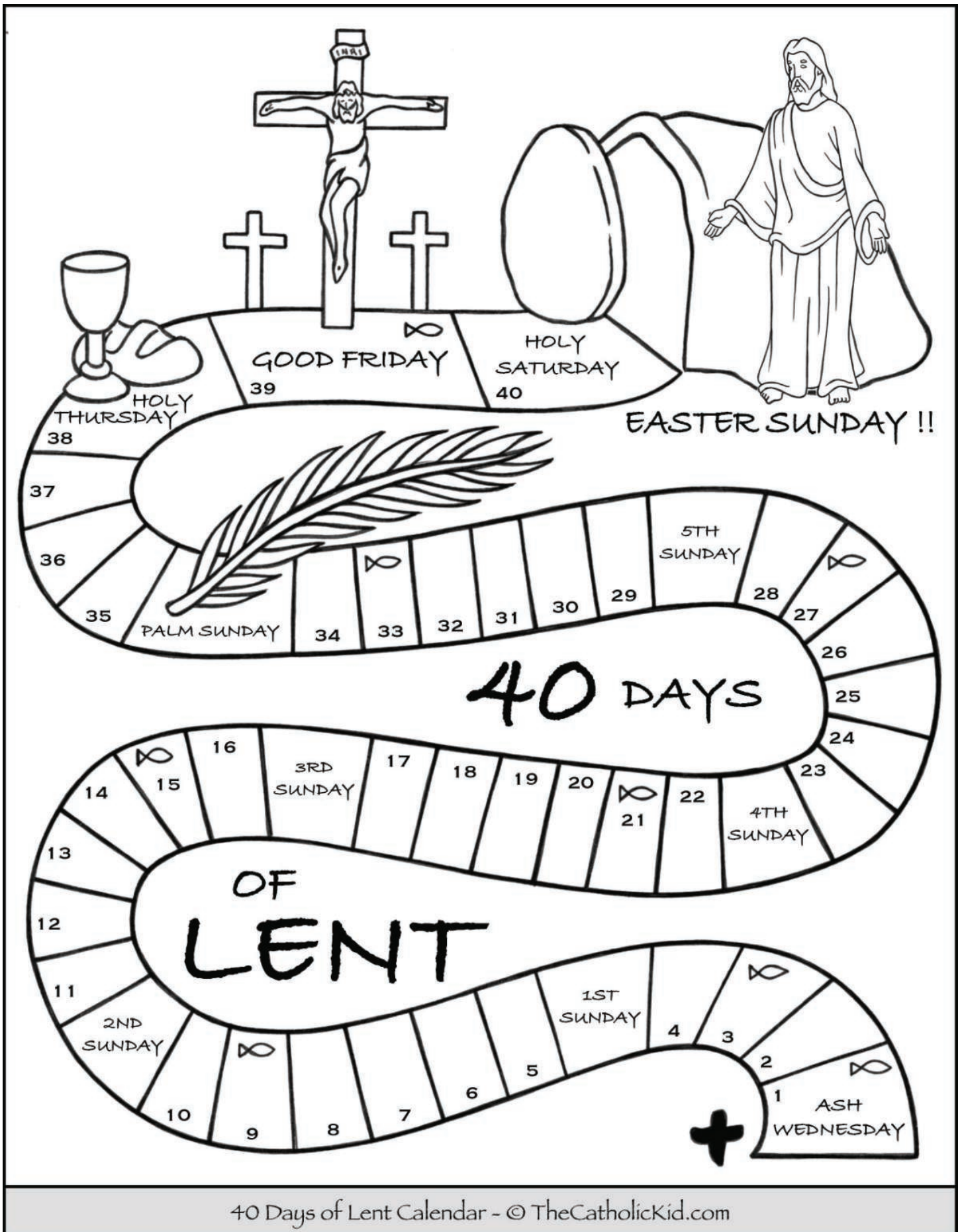
