Requirements for Sponsorship

The Code of Canon Law specifies the requirements for serving as a godparent or sponsor. Canon Law (Church Law) references are Canons 851.2, and 872-874. Godparents and sponsors must meet all of the following requirements, so please review them carefully before choosing godparents and sponsors.

The requirements to be a godparent/sponsor:

Must be someone other than the parent of the one to be baptized.

Must have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Holy Eucharist, and Confirmation.

Must be at least 16 years of age.

If there will be two Godparents (for Baptism), one must be male and one must be female.

A Godparent/sponsor must be leading a life in harmony with the faith and the role to be undertaken; therefore, if married, must be married in the Church. If single, must be striving to live a chaste life and cannot be living with a person outside of marriage.

Must be a practicing Catholic, registered in a parish, who regularly attends Mass on Sundays and Holy Days and receives the Holy Eucharist. Registration in their local parish is encouraged so that they may participate fully in the life of the Church through their parish.

WHAT IS DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY

Divine Mercy Sunday is a Catholic feast day celebrated on the second Sunday of Easter, focusing on Jesus's Love and Mercy. It is particularly associated with the visions and messages received by St. Faustina Kowalska in the 1930s, who was asked by Jesus to establish a feast day dedicated to His mercy.

We will have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament and Benediction, the Divine Mercy Chaplet and Confessions, in the main Church. 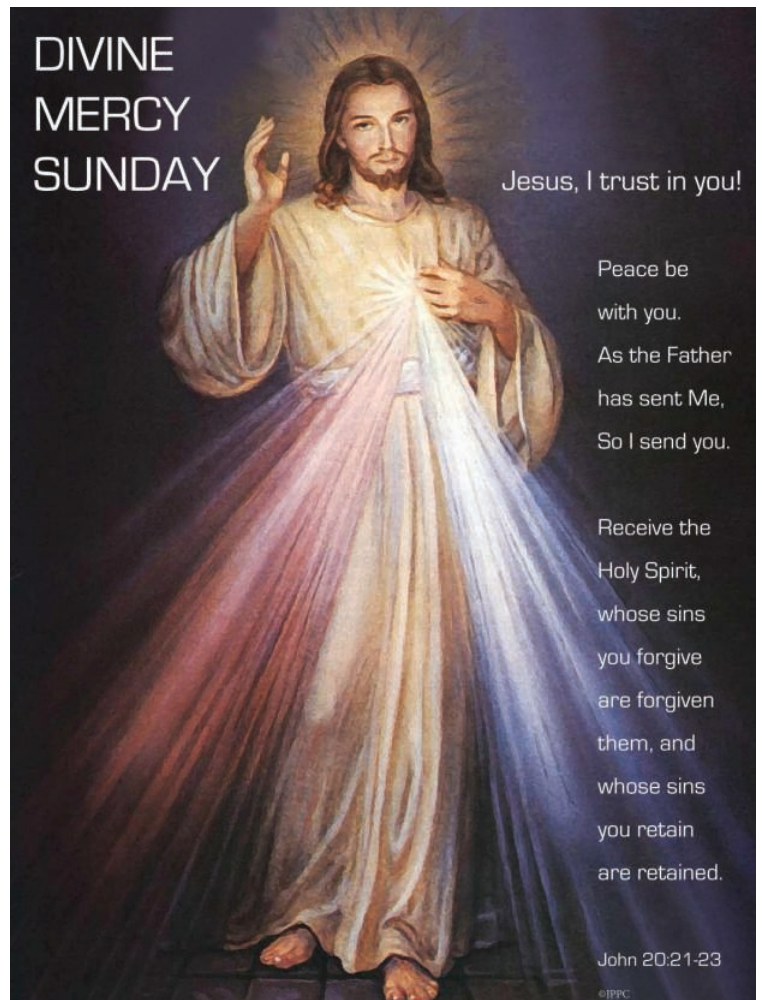
What is a plenary indulgence?

In the Catholic Church, a **plenary indulgence** is a full remission of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, granted to a faithful Christian who is duly disposed and meets specific conditions

Recited each day in the St. Theresa Chapel at 3:00 PM, at the hour Jesus died by crucifixion, which is called the Hour of Mercy.

Next Sunday - Divine Mercy Sunday

Jesus promised extraordinary grace today. He told St. Faustina: "I desire that the Feast of Mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day the very depths of My tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of My mercy."

The soul that will go to Confession* and receive Holy Communion [on this day]** shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment. On that day all the divine floodgates through which graces flow are opened. Let no soul fear to draw near to Me, even though its sins be as scarlet. My mercy is so great that no mind, be it of man or of angel, will be able to fathom it throughout all eternity. ... The Feast of Mercy emerged from My very depths of tenderness. It is My desire that it be solemnly celebrated on the first Sunday after Easter. Mankind will not have peace until it turns to the Fount of My Mercy." (Diary §699).

*Confession within a reasonable time before the Feast is sufficient. One must be in the state of grace to receive the extraordinary grace promised by Our Lord.

2025



2025 is the Jubilee Holy Year, the 2,025th anniversary of the Incarnation of our Lord, an "event of great spiritual, ecclesial, and social significance in the life of the Church." The concept of "Jubilee" has its origins in the Book of Leviticus (chapter 25) as a special year of reconciliation, pilgrimage, and coming home. Pope Francis has designated the 2025 Holy Year as a time to renew ourselves as "Pilgrims of Hope."

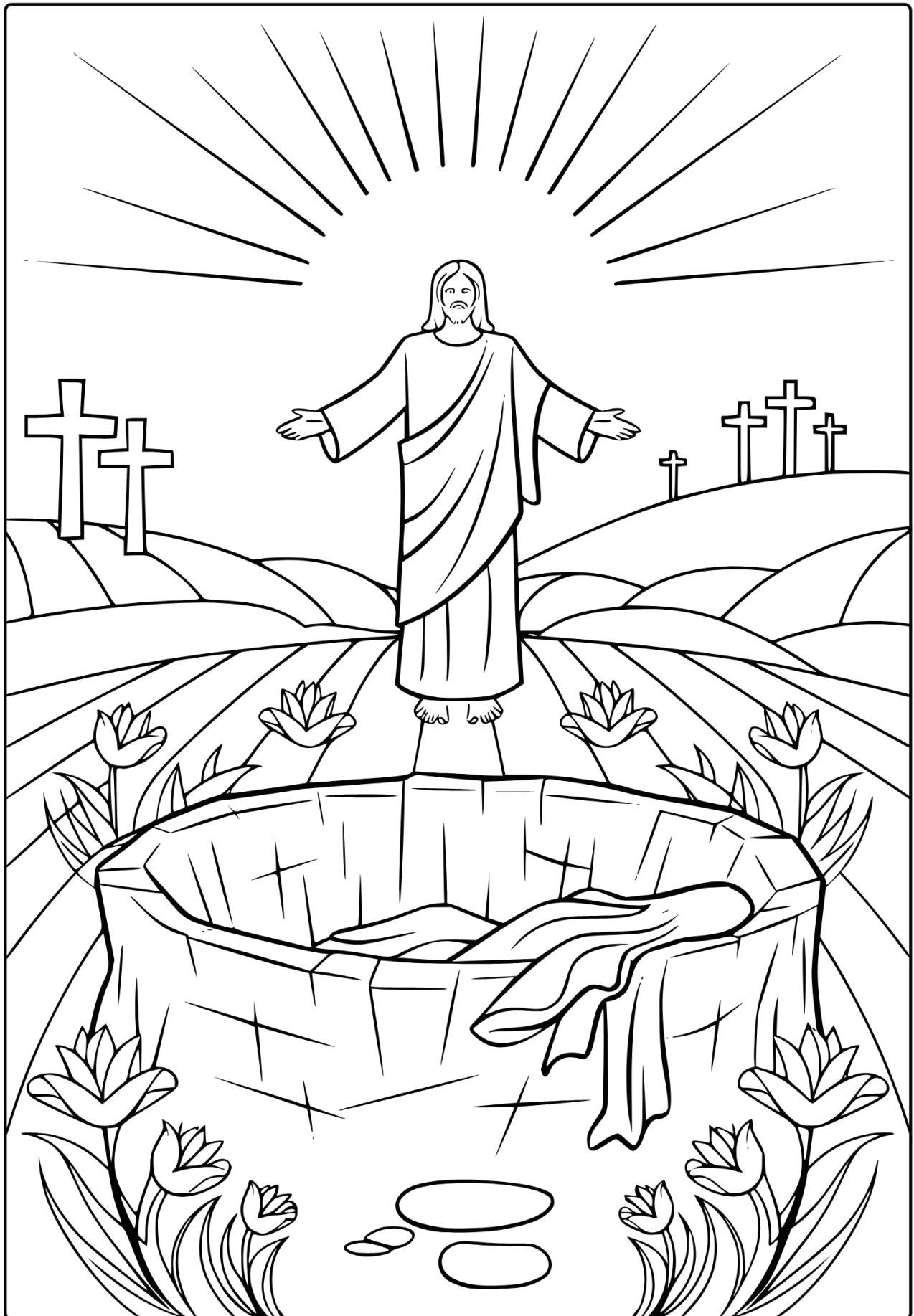
